The COURSES / SYMPOSIA should be focused on a specific theme related to Motor Control and should aim to:

- Offer in-depth exploration of current research, developments, and trends in the field.
- Provide a forum for interdisciplinary discussion and collaboration among experts in Motor Control.
- Present new and innovative ideas and approaches to the challenges facing the field.
- Foster the exchange of knowledge and ideas between researchers, practitioners, and stakeholders.

The 2-hour COURSES / SYMPOSIA will be scheduled as a pre-conference session on September 27 2023, at Auditorium Valerio Nobili. Viale Ferdinando Baldelli, 38, Rome.

Proposals should include the following information:

- Title of the symposium.
- A brief description of the topic and its relevance to the conference theme (word limit: 250 words)
- Names, contact information, affiliations, and brief biographies of the proposed symposium chair(s) and speakers (up to 4 speakers per symposium).
- A tentative schedule of presentations and discussions.
- A list of expected outcomes and impacts of the symposium.

Submission deadline: April 30 2023.

Acceptance notifications will be sent out by May 31 2023.

The Scientific Organizing Committee of Progress in Motor Control will review each proposal. The registration fee for the conference will be waived for the Chair(s).
